

Status: global comparison 2002

In our global comparison article, we provide a breakdown of results from our Status surveys over the past year. In this article, it is possible to compare the nationality breakdown for international students across the major language teaching markets in the world.



All figures relate to surveys assessing 2002 data. **Australia:** Total student weeks represented were 474,315 across 25 organisations (some with multiple centres), **Canada:** Total student weeks represented were 311,943 across 31 organisations (some with multiple centres), **France:** Total student weeks represented were 185,990 across 12 organisations **Germany:** Total student weeks represented were 193,776 across nine organisations (some with multiple centres), **Ireland:** Total student weeks represented were 19,616 across 10 organisations **Italy:** Total student weeks represented were 3,381 across eight organisations **Malta:** Total student weeks represented were 38,634 across six organisations **NZ:** Total student weeks represented were 173,899 across 16 organisations (some with multiple centres) **Spain:** Total student weeks represented were 162,786 across 18 organisations (some with multiple centres) **UK:** Total student weeks represented were 215,222 across 19 organisations (some with multiple centres) **USA:** Total student weeks represented were 123,720 across 22 organisations
