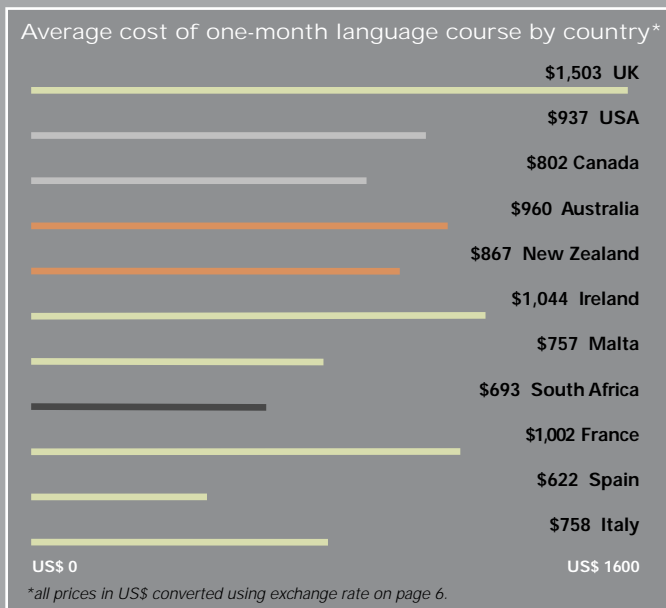
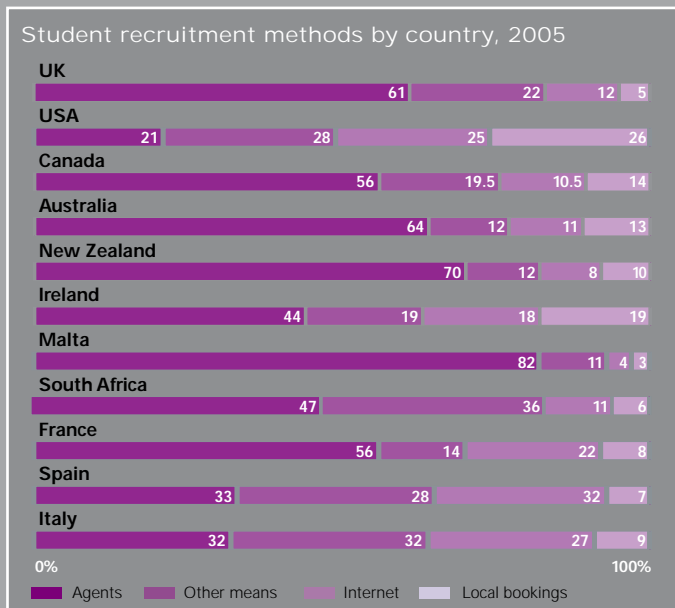


Global comparison

In our global comparison article, we provide a breakdown of results from our Status surveys over the past year. In this article, it is possible to compare the nationality breakdown for international students across the major language teaching markets in the world for 2005.



All figures relate to 2005 data: **Australia:** Total student weeks represented were 290,836 across 19 organisations **Canada:** Total student weeks represented were 507,807 across 43 organisations **France:** Total student weeks represented were 51,900 across eight organisations **Ireland:** Total student weeks represented were 111,942 across 17 organisations **Italy:** Total student weeks represented were 18,318 across 12 organisations **Malta:** Total student weeks represented were 120,964 across 11 organisations **New Zealand:** Total student weeks represented were 49,894 across 12 organisations **South Africa:** Total student weeks represented were 47,457, across eight organisations **Spain:** Total student weeks represented were 171,275 across 19 organisations **UK:** Total student weeks represented were 461,272 across 35 organisations **USA:** Total student weeks represented were 262,755 across 26 organisations
